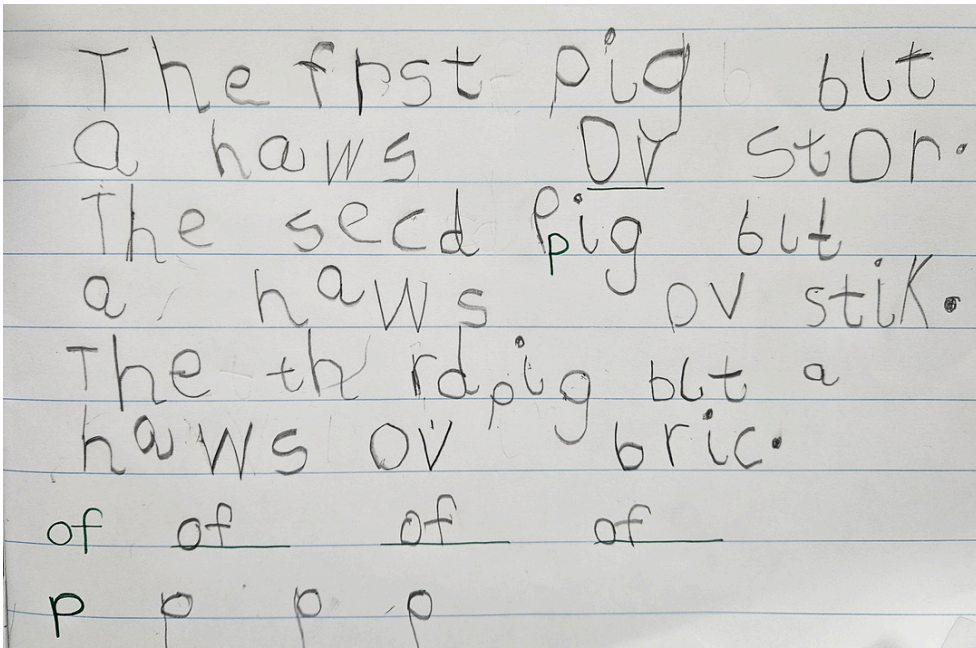

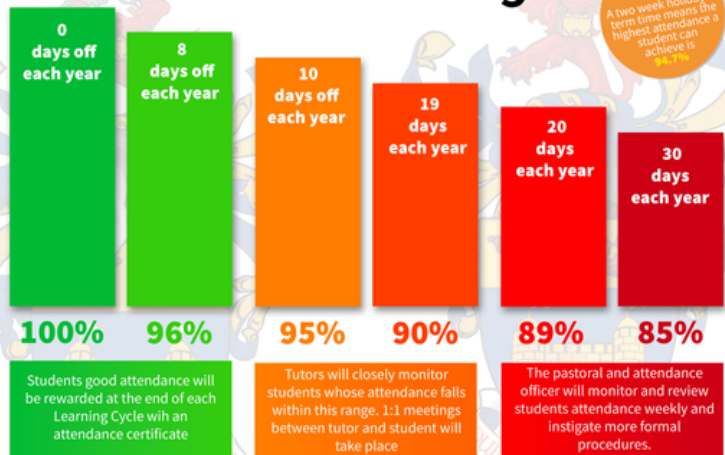


"The first pig build a house of straw. The second pig Built a house of stick. The third pig built a house of brick."
