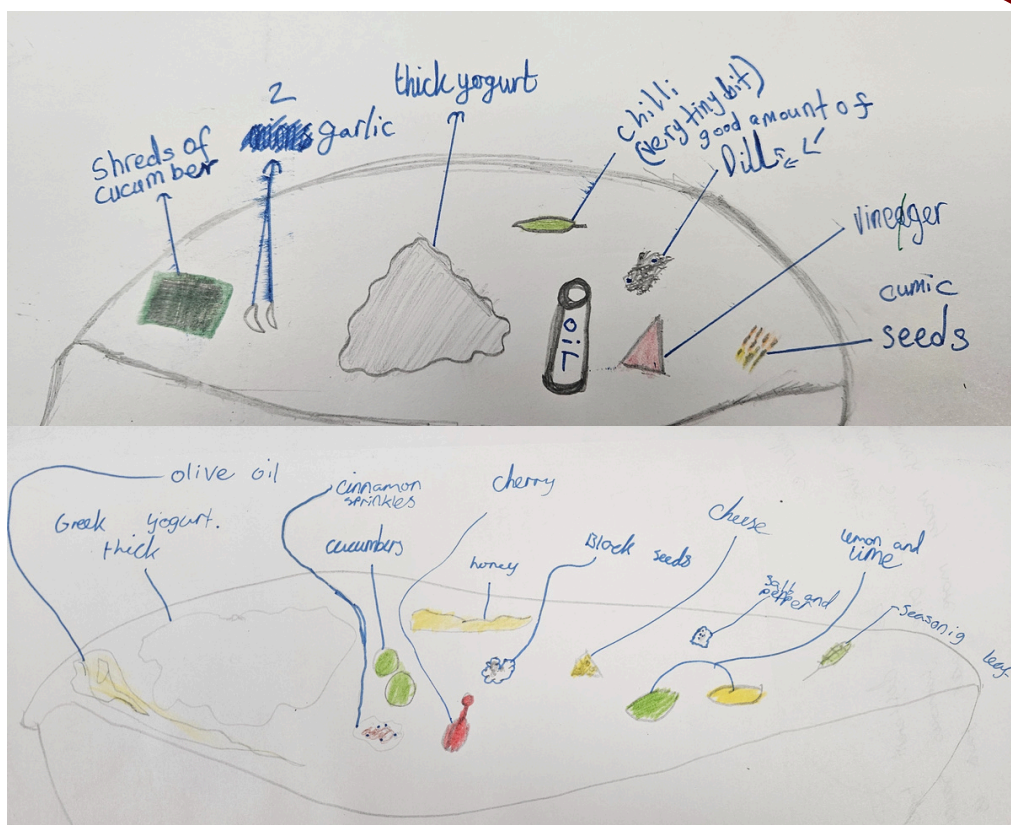

Padlet

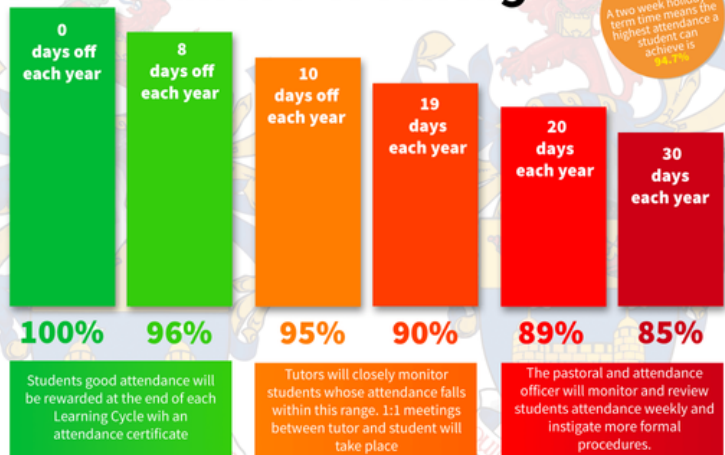

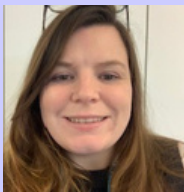
