Mrs Iqbal - Receptionist and Attendance Officer

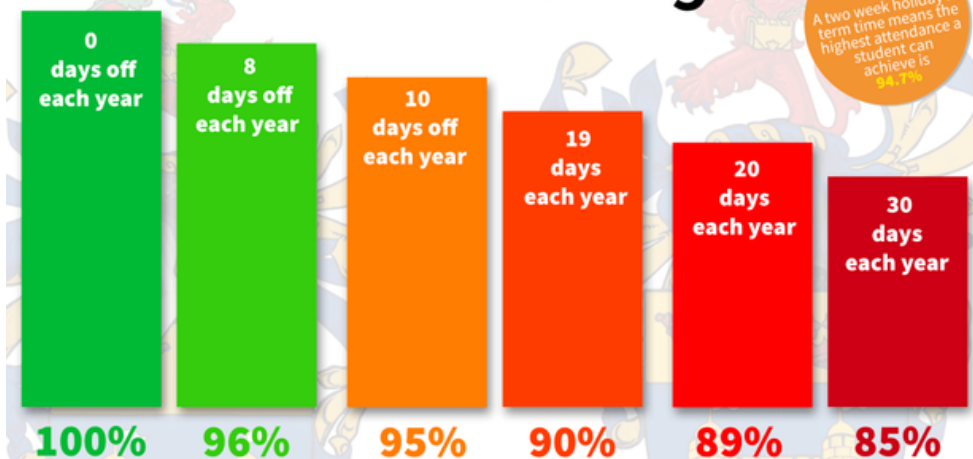
