village	A group of houses and buildings, smaller than a town.
town	A build-up area with a name, local government and is larger than a village but smaller than a city.
city	A large dense town.
skyscraper	A very tall building of many storeys.
landmarks	An object or feature of a landscape or town that is easily recognised and seen.
