School Streets

Our School Street starts soon

Thank you for having your say on the School Street consultation back in the summer. We are delighted to share with you that the scheme will be going ahead from October. The School Street will help us to help you to stay safe as you and your children travel to school each day. This will be a short closure of the area around our school to through traffic at the start and end of the school day, making the road a less congested, safer, quieter, more pleasant place for you all. Residents will still have access, as will blue badge holders, but no other parents or carers will be allowed to drive into the street during the operational hours. There will be a barrier placed at the closure to stop vehicles from entering the school street.

Volunteers needed

To help us deliver this important scheme we are asking for volunteers. We are looking for parents, carers, residents or community members to manage the barrier on a rota basis, each morning and afternoon. All you need to do is to put the barrier in place on the road, stay with it during the closure period so you can move the barrier as needed for permit holders to enter or leave the closure and put the barrier away at the end of the timed closure. You will be provided with in person, online or pre-recorded training, guidance, a hi vis jacket and support from us here at the school.
